Prerequisites For Approval for a Bonds of Marian Love Missionary

1. The applicant must meet the requirements listed below.
2. You must wait an average of **one to two months** from the date that the applicant provided the application, for a first interview, which will be assessed if the applicant has been complying with these requirements. **(To submit an application, the applicant must already be Consecrated or in process of consecration for a minimum of 3 months).**
3. **For the second interview**, it is a requirement that the applicant is actively participating in the class for Saint Lawrence, delivered each Monday.
4. After conducting the second interview the **applicant must pass the test at the end of the Saint Lawrence lessons**, to stay registered as an active missionary of the Bonds of Marian Love movement, otherwise, they will continue in Bonds as a candidate.
5. The applicant will receive a welcome letter delivered if they have been accepted as a missionary with the respective resume, which must be completed fully including photograph, and given to the Local Secretary as soon as possible.
6. Finally, the aspiring missionary must wait until the ceremony of imposition of t-shirts, where shirts and the internal rules of the Bonds of Marian Love movement will be given, to receive a shirt.

VIRTUES OF A BML MISSIONARY

Those who are integrated to the BML movement, renounce vices and strive to cultivate the virtues of charity, humility, obedience, purity, etc. voluntarily submitting to the rules of the community.

KINDS OF MISSIONARIES

- Friends of the community: do not carry distinctive t-shirt from the community
- Participant: light blue shirt (Represents faith)
- Committed: dark blue shirt (Represents hope)
- Consecrated: red shirt (Represents charity)

REQUIREMENTS FOR BEING A BML MISSIONARY

Note: Although the conditions set out below will be met, the choice of the Missionary will be subject to the discretion of the Local Director, who, guided by the Holy Spirit and in consultation with the Local Council, will make the decision.

PARTICIPANT

1. Has attended a BML spiritual retreat. In special cases, the local director shall make relevant decision.
2. To have made a general confession of all their life (we suggest the examination of conscience from the book Without Prayer There is no Salvation by LAM available on the BML website).
3. Want to renounce the world to serve God.
4. Must be fully consecrated to Jesus by Mary through the method of St. Louis Mary Grignion de Montfort or to be in preparation for Consecration for a **MINIMUM OF 3 MONTHS**.

RECOMMENDED BOOKS FOR CONSECRATION:

- Preparation for total consecration, Totus Tuus
- Secret of Mary
- Treatise on True Devotion
- Marian Slavery

5. The aspiring missionary must remain in the grace of God, frequenting the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
6. Periodically attend to the different activities of the Community.
7. Have the interviews with the committee in charge, for their approval and fill the respective request.
