PRAYERS

1. OPENING PRAYERS

By the sign of the Holy Cross (+), from our enemies (+), deliver us O Lord Our God (+), in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

2. ACT OF CONTRITION

Close your eyes and remember all of the things (actions, words, thoughts and omissions) with which you have offended the Lord. With profound repentance we pray:

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against You whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with Your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In His name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

3. APOSTLE'S CREED

I believe in God, the Almighty Father, creator of Heaven and Earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.



4. INTENTIONS AND FATIMA PRAYERS

Offer this Rosary for your intentions.

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love You! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love You. (Repeat 3x)

Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, I adore You profoundly. I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference by which He is offended. And, through the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of You the conversion of sinners. Amen.

5. INVOCATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Come, Holy Spirit, come by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Your well beloved spouse. (Repeat 3x). Amen.

6. MEDITATION OF THE MYSTERY

Mediate on the mystery and pray an "Our Father," ten "Hail Marys," and a "Glory be."

V. Mary is the mother of grace, mother of mercy,
R. In life and in death, be our help and our protection.

7. ASPIRATION PRAYERS

Jesus, my God, mayest Thou be ever known, adored, loved and praised every moment in the most holy and Divine Sacrament.

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy. Amen.
